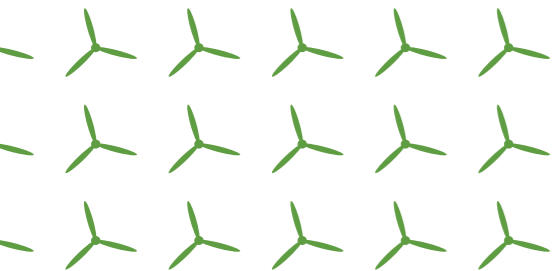
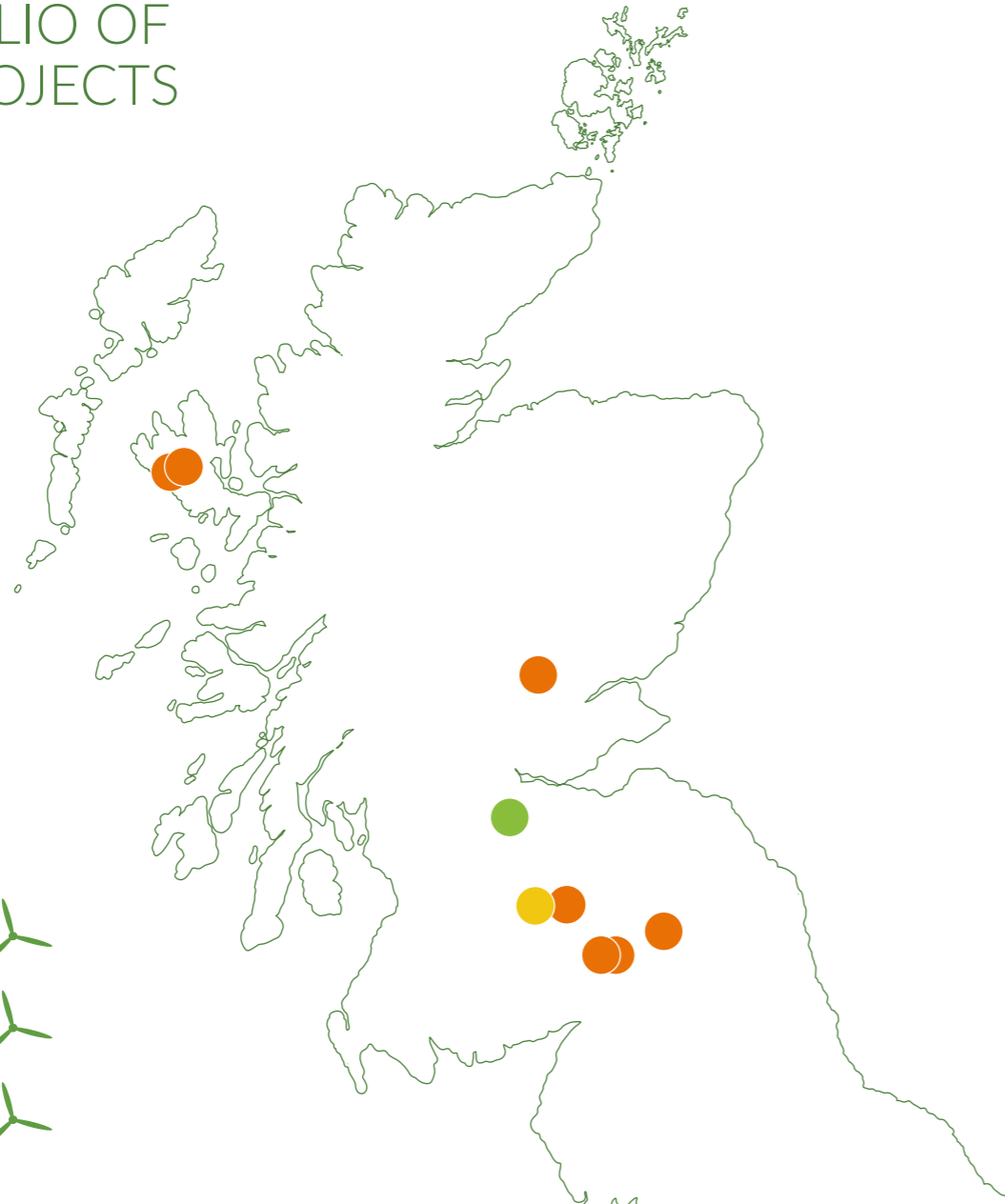

# TAILORED COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

We are committed to delivering a tailored approach to community engagement. Alongside attendance at community council meetings and hosting consultation events in local halls, we are always looking at better ways to share project updates and engage with local residents and businesses providing the opportunity to meaningfully influence the development of our sites.



For our North Logiealmond Wind Farm we worked with Pegasus Group, a leading development consultancy, to create an interactive visualisation tool for a series of pre-submission community drop-in events which was very well received.

Our Glen Ullinish II project team sponsored the Dunvegan Agricultural Show and hosted an information stand, a great opportunity to engage with a wide range of local residents and answer questions about the project.



We asked the communities hosting our Priestgill Wind Farm construction works how they'd prefer to receive updates and have been providing social media friendly graphics and posters to put up in local shops in addition to email and written updates to those who requested them.

Supporting local events, such as funding fairs and agricultural shows, increases our accessibility within communities, helps us learn more about local priorities, opportunities and challenges. Supporting school careers events raises awareness of the renewables career paths available to young people in these communities.



# EARLY STAGE SUPPORT

We distribute over £100,000 each year in local sponsorships and small grants to the communities in close proximity to our development sites.

This early funding empowers communities to begin delivering on their priorities and allows us to engage with more groups across the community to demonstrate our people-first approach.

## CASE STUDY

**Development:** Teviot Wind Farm  
**Donation:** £4,000  
**Location:** Hawick, the Scottish Borders



The Borders Green Team is an amazing social enterprise which provides employment and training for adults with learning disabilities in the Scottish Borders.



Working from their base in Hawick, the team offers landscaping and grass cutting services in the Summer and chop logs and kindling for customers in the Winter. They also make a range of garden furniture including benches, planters and bird boxes.

Through our community investment funding, we have supported the Green Team by funding the maintenance of their van, ensuring they have reliable transportation to continue their fantastic work in the community.

**Development:** North Logiealmond Wind Farm  
**Donation:** £3,200  
**Location:** Perth, Perth & Kinross



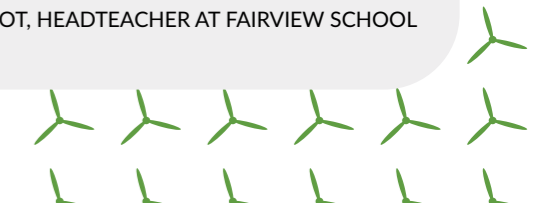
Muirhall Energy partnered with Perth-based renewable energy installer Broden Ltd to help Fairview School become more sustainable and restore an outdoor space - providing pupils with the opportunity to expand their learning.

The collaboration saw the two companies join forces to restore an off-grid solar panel and battery storage system that was first installed at the school in 2009. The upgraded system powers an external workshop building in the playground and enables it to have lighting and power throughout the year.

## CASE STUDY

### PRIESTGILL SUPPLY CHAIN EVENT – NOVEMBER 2025

The Muirhall Energy team and our main contractor for Priestgill Wind Farm, RJ McLeod, hosted a supply chain engagement event in Abington in November 2025.

We were delighted to welcome over 45 local companies, from plant hire and aggregate suppliers to food and drink providers. It was great to meet so many passionate businesses, make new connections, and explore opportunities to collaborate on the construction of Priestgill Wind Farm.

This engagement has resulted in contracts being placed with various local businesses, providing plant hire, material testing, aggregate supply and concrete pouring services.

## CONSTRUCTION STAGE FUNDING – INITIAL INVESTMENT FUND (IIF)

Available to local communities in close proximity to our projects once construction formally commences. The fund is managed inhouse by Muirhall Energy with funding based on a figure of **£5,000 per turbine**.

## CASE STUDY

Priestgill Wind Farm Initial Investment Fund benefitted community groups, clubs and charities based within the Crawford & Elvanfoot and Duneaton Community Council areas in South Lanarkshire.

**£35,000** was available during the construction period and applications from community groups and charities for grants of up to **£2,500** were invited.

Examples of awards include:

- £5,800 to local Primary Schools for outdoor learning equipment and field trips.
- £5,000 towards energy efficiency improvements in community buildings.
- £2,700 towards new sound system and floor cleaning machine for two local halls
- £4,900 towards Greenkeeping Equipment and ground maintenance at Abington and Crawford Bowling Clubs
- £4,700 towards community social events

## OPERATIONAL STAGE FUNDING – COMMUNITY INVESTMENT FUND (CIF)

Delivered once construction is complete and the wind farm is generating, Muirhall Energy is proud to offer an industry leading £7,000 per MW for all new sites based on the site’s generational capacity.

This fund is index-linked for the lifetime of the project and, over the 40-year lifespan of the average windfarm is transformative, allowing investment in multi-year projects and larger capital projects to be considered.

With funding distributed **by** communities, **in** communities and **for** communities this funding has the potential to reduce barriers and increase opportunities for this generation and the next.

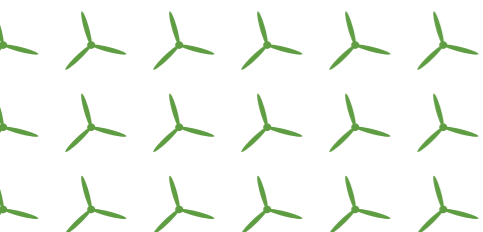
## CASE STUDY

### GREENGAIRS EAST WIND FARM

Greengairs East Wind Farm has been operational since summer 2023 and will provide £4.5million in community benefit over its lifetime.

Five North Lanarkshire communities share £180,000 community investment funding each year and they were each able to decide how they’d like to manage it. One portion is managed by the local community council, three communities receive their funds directly but have administrative support from Foundation Scotland while the fifth has Foundation Scotland managing their fund for them but with funding awards decided by a local funding panel. **You can read more here: <https://www.foundationscotland.org.uk/apply-for-funding/funding-available/greengairs-east-wind-farm-community-benefit-fund>**

The funding has supported a wide variety of community events, local kids clubs, parent & toddler groups, senior citizens club outings and a contribution to a volunteer transport service for cancer patients.
